Agenda item 1: Principal's Report - Principal Elba Herrera

We are in Week 3 of Bullying Prevention. We had a school wide assembly on Bullying & Kindness Prevention on October 18th. Teachers are getting ready for Parent/Teacher Conferences that will take place on November 9-16. Conference days will be early dismissal days for students.

Agenda item 3: Trunk or Treat

- Scheduled for Friday 10/27, 5:30-7:30p 20 Official Cars have registered.
 Parking lot to be blocked off by 3p. Volunteers can arrive by 4p to set-up. Parking spots will be numbered to better assign. Teachers and staff that are not participating, need to move their cars from the parking lot by 3:30pm.
- Requests were posted on ParentSquare, FB and IG for donations of treats and sweets. No donations have been turned in.
- Board Members approved buying treats to hand out.
- Costco donated \$50 for our event snacks have been purchased.
- Contract made with JG Trees for 100 pumpkins to be delivered on the day of the event. Payment expected at delivery.
- Flyers reminding parents of the event sent out this week (note included for donations and volunteers still welcomed). Still need more volunteers to monitor and help with the pumpkin patch.

Discussed: Ricardo suggested next year we should include the Fire Department (they often bring their Fire Truck). A PASS table was considered, settled on giving out PASS stickers and possibly Flyers. People will be expected to park on the Street. Next year should let neighbors know about the event in advance. Asked Principal Herrera if her Staff could move their cars by 3:30pm (if not participating).

Agenda item 4: 5th Grade T-Shirt Contest - Deadline October 31st

- Goal is to have the t-shirts before Science Camp in December.
- 5th grade students have the Contest Sheet. Expected to turn in by October 31st.
- Voting among students will be in early November.

Discussed: Mr. Saad stated that only two 5th grade students have turned in a Contest Sheet. A reminder may need to be sent out (paper is due October 31st). At the end the whole school will vote on the winner (like last year). Maribel suggested opening the competition for all students next year.

Dear Parents and Schilling Staff (PASS),

My name is Maria Gutierrez, and I am the Lead Coordinator and one of the dance teachers for Schilling School Ballet Folklorico. We are fortunate to have a second dance teacher that comes from out of town to choreograph. For the last couple years our dance group has been small, in large part due to the pandemic. This year we were able to take in more students and our group has grown from about 5 to 20 dancers (all Schilling students). Our group has already danced at the Newark Day of the Dead Festival and the October 17 Board of Education Meeting.

We hope to be able to grow and include more children in the future. It takes a lot to run our Dance Group weekly especially with a bigger class. Our current dresses are almost ten years old and will soon need replacing. Accessories need to be replaced continuously. Our parents are supporting us with donations but many of them cannot regularly do so. We had a donation box at the Day of the Dead Festival and are thinking of other ways to bring in financial support.

We would appreciate any support PASS could give us. This will go to help run our dance group, start replacing dresses and needed accessories (that belong to Schilling and will be here for future use), and continue to represent Schilling Elementary wherever we are invited!

Jeff Anderson (Historian) motioned to give Schilling Folklorico \$500. Seconded by Karla Ramirez (Treasurer). All in attendance in Favor -including Lucy Rubio (Secretary).

***On 10/23/23 Laurie Garcia (President) and Jacqueline Carillo (Vice President) voted in Favor (they could not make the meeting).

Agenda item 6: Yearbook - Revisit previous discussion

- A Yearbook Committee has been created: Sara Canales, Maribel Maldonado, Laurie Garcia.
 - Information and price quotes have been gathered. Still a question of whether a yearbook interest survey should be sent out.
- Is there an email where parents and staff can start sending pictures?

Discussed: Maribel and Team have decided on Treering Website for a 50 page Yearbook. There is no minimum purchase and price is comparable to another low

option. Last year 98 Yearbooks were sold. Suggested to sell at a \$25 reduced price at the beginning of the year and raise it from there. 2 Volunteers still needed to help get it together. Ryann will help reach out to Lifetouch to get "mugs". Mrs. Madarang suggested having a contest for covers like in year's past, open to all grades. Possible theme "Schilling Rocks" like the Newark Days theme.

Agenda Item 7: Backpack Racks

- 2nd DLI Kinder backpack rack is painted and assembled. Will be installed Sunday. DLI Kinder parents funded both racks. Each rack took about 22 hours to complete. PASS has been requested to sponsor the rest of the school. Will need volunteers and possibly a simpler design.
- Any other kindergarten parent concerns.

Discussed: BackPack Project

Jeff, along with Gregg, Scott, and other Kinder parents, were able to get formal approval to put together the Kinder Backpacks. District Board Members were contacted and consulted. The racks took many more hours than 22. They will create a report/guide for others who want to take up the project for other classes. Mrs. Raber mentioned that backpacks were never an issue until classes became bigger, before that classes did fine without. It was suggested to look at other schools and what solutions they had come up with. PASS will support.

Discussed: Concerns from Kinder Parents:

BBQ Event was a great Idea but parents felt it was disorganized and short. There was no one to guide parents on where to go or what to do. Ricardo suggested more volunteers to guide people, mind the food, and help the kitchen; so that parents have more time with their children. Perhaps a separate table for those participating in the event. Ryann will ask Linda to put another request for canopies because many parents didn't want to sit in the sun. Mrs. Raber reminded that not all student's parents participate and the school may not want to interrupt their regular school day. When in doubt, email the Principal with concerns.

Kinder parents were upset there wouldn't be a Pumpkin Patch. Maribel contacted the Pumpkin Patch organizers to put one together. They will come on Wednesday 10/25 and she is requesting \$4 from parents for the pumpkins. This will include TK and Kinder. Maribel asked if PASS could supplement the difference between parent collection and total price. Everyone was In Favor. Final numbers will be given after collection. Julany volunteered to help and Ryann volunteered half day.

Maribel is starting a Book Bag Exchange for Kinder that will include 4 Bilingual Books. She will create a GoFund page and ask for parent Volunteers. Her goal is to start in January. Once she gathers the needed information she will make a formal request to PASS if needed.
